PROFESSIONAL INDEMNITY

Applicants will need to have an appropriate professional indemnity (PI) policy in place in order to indemnify themselves and SALSA of any potential claims of damages or loss from suppliers in relation to advice offered or given to suppliers in the course of representing the SALSA scheme. Evidence will be required before working for SALSA.

INDUCTION AND TRAINING

Applicants will be assessed against the Scheme requirements for auditors/mentors in their location. Where new auditors /mentors are required in an area selected applicants will be invited to an interview.

Before commencing work as a SALSA **mentor** or receiving allocated work from SALSA as an **auditor**, successful applicants must attend a one-day induction seminar. There will be no charges for attendance; travel costs will, however be at the applicant's own expense.

Thereafter, every **mentor** and **auditor** will be required to attend one day (or equivalent) SALSA auditor and mentor training seminar per year and complete alignment exercises as required.

The induction and annual training will contribute to the IFST register annual CPD requirements.

There may be additional pre-qualifications/training to undertake certain activities for SALSA
